
# **1. THEY REGISTERED FROM ACROSS THE PROVINCE**

### 5. HERE'S WHAT HAPPENS NEXT .

On **Saturday**, **Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>**, a joint meeting of the current 2017 directors and the new 2018 directors (Linda Anweiler, Ron Cherkewich, and Ron Palmer) will be held in Davidson. The purposes of the meeting will be:

- 1) To review the 2017 convention and make recommendations to the 2018 Board regarding the 2018 convention,
  - The <u>Minutes of 2017 Annual General Meeting</u> have been drafted and forwarded to the directors for review, particularly the feedback from the regional meetings.<sup>2</sup>
  - A <u>Summary Convention Evaluation Report</u> has been compiled, based on the 42 convention evaluation forms turned in at the convention.
- 2) To begin planning PARCS initiatives for 2018, including:
  - In three of the regions, volunteers have come forward to sit on an AIM to STAB<sup>3</sup> Committee to
    press the case for border checks for aquatic invasive mussels. The Board will consider the
    establishment of such a regional committee at this Nov. 18 meeting, as well as the committee's
    mandate and operation. Stand by for more information to follow.
  - Other issues that were introduced in President Dixon's convention address and prioritized in the regional meetings, for PARCS' 2018 **promotion with government officials**.
